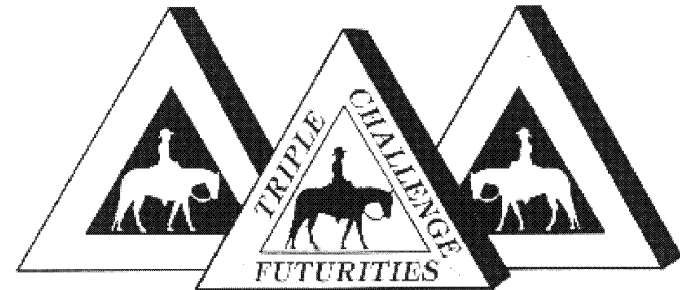

Futurity Information

The Triple Challenge Futurity is open to all breeds. Entries do not need to be in the stallion trust program to show. If a yearling, two year old or three year old entry is by a stallion that has been sold through the stallion trust program for 2012, that entry is eligible for both futurity and trust purses. No additional entry forms are required. Be sure to include all information on the enclosed entry blank, especially the sire. We cannot be responsible for purses not paid because of incomplete entries.

FORMAT: All classes are one go-round with four judges. The low score will be dropped for the placings. The low score will be recovered for the pay-backs. 55% to 80% of entries will be jackpotted in addition to the added money. The maiden 2 yr. old STAKES western pleasure class will pay on the average only. Low score will be dropped.

One payment only. April 1 is the first payment opportunity. Each entry must have a stall. Stalls come with 5 bags of bedding included.

All Futurity payments must be postmarked by the due date or late fees will apply. You may pay by check or call in with Master Card or Visa. If you call in, it is your responsibility to complete the call. Substitutions are allowed by paying the late fee depending on when the substitution is made.

NSBA APPROVED CLASSES: All NSBA approved classes will be run in accordance with NSBA eligibility rules. Please be sure you are eligible before entering

STAKES SALE: Saturday, June 30. Open to yearlings only. Entries in this sale will return next year to show for GUARANTEED \$30,000 to the winner. It will pay down as many places as is needed by the number shown.

STAKES 2 yr old western pleasure class. Open only to those maiden 2 yr. olds who sold in the 2011 stakes sale.
